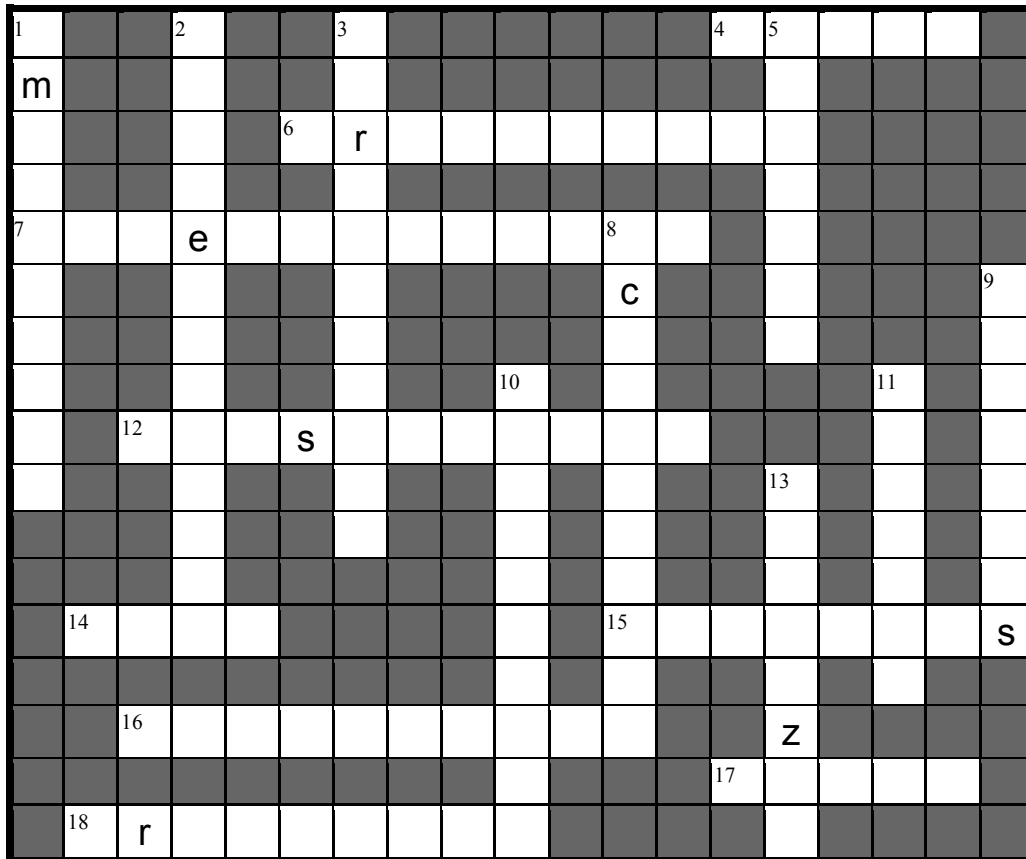

4. These animals have feathers (5)
6. A group of animal species which have jointed legs and a hard body covering (10)
7. Animals without a backbone (13)
12. Crabs, lobsters, prawns and crayfish, for example (11)
14. Characterized by scales, gills and a backbone (4)
15. Scaly bodied vertebrates that live on land (8)
16. Worm-like arthropods with many pairs of legs (but not a thousand), and which feed on rotting plant material (10)
17. This group has members which are flat, round and segmented (5)
18. Spiders, scorpions and ticks, for example (9)

## Down

1. Vertebrates which can survive on land and in water (10)
2. Sea anemones, jelly-fish and coral, for example (13)
3. Animals with a backbone (11)
5. Arthropods with 6 legs and usually wings (7)
8. Starfish, sea urchins and sea cucumbers, for example (11)
9. Snails, slugs, oysters, and the octopus are examples of this soft-bodied group of animals (8)
10. These worm-like arthropods are actually venomous predators (10)
11. A group of warm-blooded vertebrates which suckle their young (7)
13. Single-celled organisms (8)
