- 4. Warm blooded animals with feathers
- 6. A group of animal species which have jointed legs and a hard body covering
- 7. Animals without a backbone
- 12. Crabs, lobsters, prawns and crayfish, for example
- 14. Characterized by scales, gills and a backbone
- 15. Scaly bodied vertebrates that live on land
- Worm-like arthropods with many pairs of legs (but not a thousand), and which feed on rotting plant material
- This group has members which are flat, round and segmented
- 18. Spiders, scorpions and ticks, for example

- Vertebrates which spend time on land and in water
- 2. Sea anemones, jelly-fish and coral, for example
- 3. Animals with a backbone
- 5. Arthropods with 6 legs and usually wings
- 8. Starfish, sea urchins and sea cucumbers, for example
- 9. Snails, slugs, oysters, and the octopus are examples of this soft-bodied group of animals
- 10. These worm-like arthropods are actually venomous predators
- 11. A group of warm-blooded vertebrates which suckle their young
- 13. Single-celled organisms
