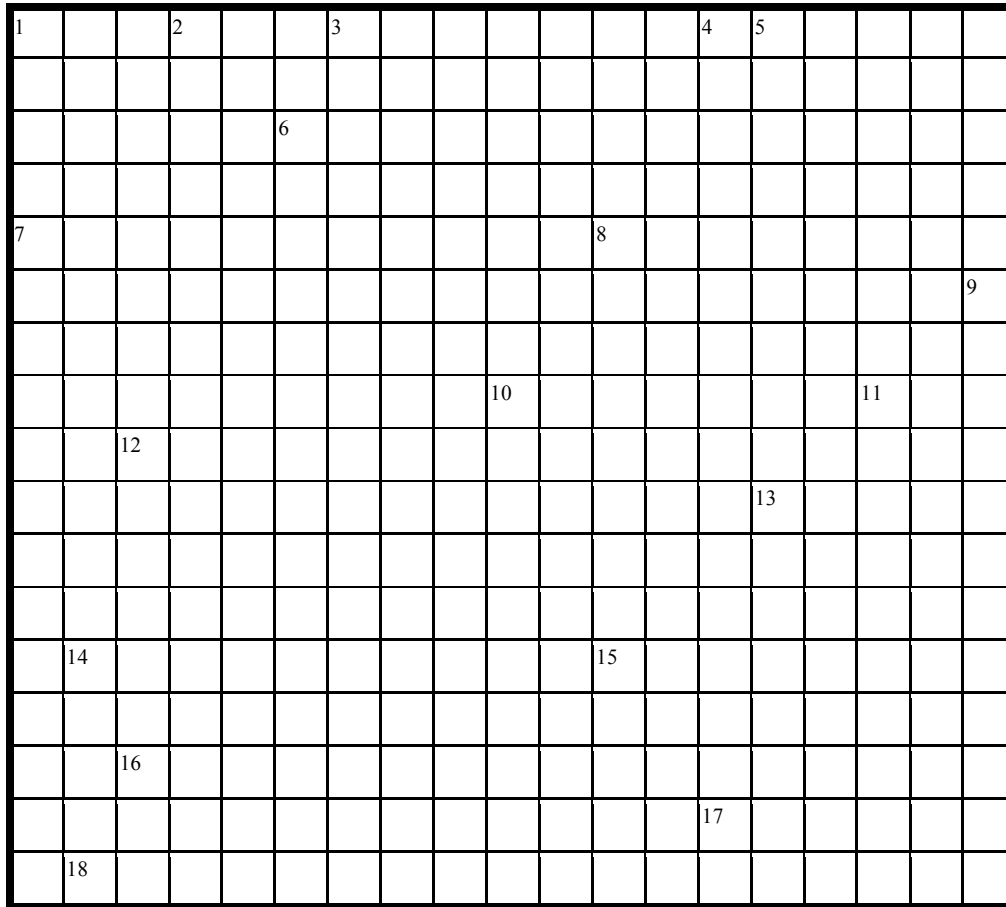

4. These egg laying vertebrates share a common ancestry with the reptiles
6. A group characterized by an exoskeleton, segmented bodies, and jointed legs
7. All animals that do not lie in the phylum '*chordata*'
12. Arthropods which have gills for breathing
14. The oldest vertebrates
15. Characterized by scales, a backbone and their variable body temperature
16. Worm-like arthropods with many pairs of legs, and which feed on rotting plant material
17. This group includes *Phylum Nematoda* and *Phylum Annelida*
18. This animals in this group have four pairs of walking legs

1. These animals generally live on land, but lay their eggs in water.
2. These include the *class hydrozoa*, the *class scyphozoa* and the *class anthozoa*
3. The major sub-set of the phylum '*chordata*'
5. Arthropods which have 3 body parts
8. The spiny skinned animals
9. A variety of soft bodied animals, placed in this group due to their common ancestry
10. These worm-like arthropods are actually venomous predators
11. A group whose animals have a highly developed cerebrum
13. These single-celled organisms were the earth's first animals
